SUSTAINABLE PROCUREMENT POLICY

Indian Institute of Technology - Roorkee is among the foremost institutes of national importance in higher technological education, engineering, and basic and applied research. IIT Roorkee has rigorous and stringent purchasing rules. These rules are derived from the GFR-2017(General Financial Rules) and are designed to protect public funds from unfair usage and demonstrate fair usage to the public. In addition to the IIT Roorkee Store & Purchase Rule-2018, the following procurement practices must be followed:

- Prioritize procurements of products and services with a lower environmental impact, including those with reduced energy consumption, resource-efficient materials, and eco-friendly packaging.
- All equipment, machinery, and items procured should have been assessed to have a minimum negative impact on the environment, pollution, and lifestyle of the students and staff and the community living around the IIT Roorkee Campus.
- Procurements and use of paper and ink should be minimized through digital platforms, networking, and process automation.
- The institute has placed different waste bins for biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste at different places on campus. Recycling of biodegradable wastes in IIT Roorkee should be maximized, and green technologies should be promoted in different operations of the IIT Roorkee.
- The institute periodically calls for donations of IT products (Computers, printers, etc.), educational material, and reusable furniture. Become part of a donation drive for IT Products (Computers, Printers, etc.) and reusable furniture.
- While procurement is done for similar-cost items and quality, we should aspire to promote local products to ensure a lower carbon footprint due to the procurement process.
- IIT Roorkee Green Committee conducts a Green Audit of its curriculum and institutional management practices, such as energy, water, waste, construction projects, natural resources (forest, water, etc.), and biodiversity conservation. When approached by the Green Committee, all stakeholders should provide full support to the Green Committee for required data and details as and when desired by the Green Committee.
